STALLION NEWS

FLYING START FOR HEDGEHOLME STUD

As if it were not enough that Hedgeholme Stud had the first British-based first season sire off the mark in 2005, they also stand the second. **Hunting Lion** started the ball rolling when his son **Garlogs** won at Doncaster on 1st April, and his stud companion **Rambling Bear**'s second runner, **The Bear**, scored in the opener at yesterday's Newcastle meeting. The white-blazed chesnut took the lead at half way and held on stoutly by half a length.

Rambling Bear raced for seven seasons, winning seven times and finishing placed on 12 occasions from 57 starts – 48 of which were Group or Listed events. He won the Gr.3 King George Stakes at three, beating Gr.1 winner **Hever Golf Rose**, the Gr.3 Palace House Stakes at six and two Listed races.

He stands at Hedgeholme Stud in County Durham at £1,200 and Hunting Lion's fee is £2,000. The two sires have just 21 two-year-olds between them.

Hedgeholme Stud have a third first season sire, the Gr.2 winner **Lear Spear**, who has yet to have a runner, and are also standing **Shinko Forest** for Rathbarry Stud.

RACING REVIEW

HEDGEHUNTER SPRINTS HOME AT AINTREE

Trevor Hemmings, a long-time supporter of National Hunt racing, finally achieved a 34-year ambition yesterday when his nine-year-old **Hedgehunter** won the Grand National. Hemmings had the misfortune to

lose his classy staying chaser **The Last Fling** in the 2002 National, but Lady Luck has been smiling on him lately – he finally had his first two Cheltenham Festival winners last month when **Trabolgan** won the Gr.1 Royal and SunAlliance Chase and **Juveigneur** the Kim Muir Chase.

Yesterday's Grand National had been billed as one of the most competitive in living memory, with the past three winners taking part again and all 40 runners in the handicap proper. But it was turned into a rout close home, as Hedgehunter sprinted clear on the long run-in. As usual, there were hard luck stories, not least the one concerning Tony McCoy whose mount, the well-backed **Clan Royal**, was carried out by a loose horse when holding a clear lead at the second Bechers.

All being well, the winner may tackle the Grand Steeplechase de Paris next month.

SECOND LISTED SUCCESS FOR PATRIARCH'S BOSS

The Clive Brittain-trained **Party Boss** recorded his sixth successive victory, and his second easy Listed win, in the International Trial Stakes at Lingfield.

The flying grey is a son of The National Stud's **Silver Patriarch**, a Listed winner at two and a top class middle distance horse for the following three seasons. He stands at a 2005 fee of £2,500.

Never one to miss an opportunity, Brittain's charge will next run in the 2000 Guineas.

The Aga Khan Stud's four times Gr.1 winner **Sendawar** sired his eighth individual winner of the season when **Sandja** scored by an effortless five lengths at Lyon

GERMAN STALLION NEWS

GENERAL ASSEMBLY DIES AT 29

General Assembly, a Gr.1-winning son of the mighty **Secretariat**, was put down recently in Germany due to heart and circulatory problems.

The 15 length winner of the Gr.1 Travers Stakes in a record time that still stands today, General Assembly had a much-travelled stud career, having started at Giltown Stud in Ireland in 1980. He returned to his native country in 1986, spending time at two Kentucky studs before moving to France for two seasons from 1993. He then joined Gestut Olympia in Germany in 1995 and lived out his days there.

His 31 Stakes winners are headed by the Hong Kong Champion Sprinter **Steady Flame** and the Gr.1 Frizette Stakes winner **Charleston Rag**, and he has sired eight winners of nine races in Germany this year.

General Assembly's fertility had declined in recent years, and his last German foal, from three 2002 coverings, is the two-year-old filly **Rosella**. He was still advertised at stud in 2004, together with two other German-based stallions of the same great age, **Northern Dancer's** sons **Imperial Fling** and **Northern Treat**.

Anna Monda (Monsun) looked an improved filly since her only juvenile start, and cantered home seven lengths clear. Bought back for €28,000 at the BBAG Yearling Sale by Gestut Brummerhof, she is the third winner out of **Anna of Kiev (Salse)**, who ran once at two in France before passing through sales rings four times. Agent Axel Donnerstag, on behalf of Gestut Brummerhof, bought her for 28,000gns on the third occasion at the 1997 Tattersalls December Sale. Her first foal, **Doctor Lanni (Scenic)**, has won 13 races in Italy, and the four times winner **Anno Mundi (Acatenango)**, is one of three surviving foals she produced during her seven years in Germany. The second dam, the unraced **Anna Matrushka (Mill Reef)**, foaled ten winners from 12 foals including three Group scorers, dual Gr.2 victrix **Annaba (In the Wings)**, Gr.3 Park Hill Stakes winner **Anna of Saxony (Ela-Mana-Mou)** and the French Gr.2-winning stayer **Pozarica (Rainbow Quest)**. The third dam **Anna Paola (Prince Ippi)** won the Gr.2 Preis der Diana and foaled six winners including **Anna Petrovna (Wassil)**, dam of **Annis Mirabilis**, one of the first good globetrotters for Godolphin.

Anna of Kiev was bought for 3,500gns by FBA at the 2004 Tattersalls December Sale and was exported to Azerbaijan, where she has foaled a colt by **Bertolini**.

The grandam **Shona (Windwurf)** won three of her four races, included a Listed event at three, and bred seven winners, the best of them being **Sommernacht (Monsun)**, winner of the Listed Preis der Winterkonigin and second in the Gr.3 Premio Primi Passi at two, who disappointed as second favourite in the German 1000 Guineas.

In a race where there were 21 finishers and no injuries, **Glenelly Gale (Strong Gale)** led for most of the first circuit but was headed at the Chair by **Clan Royal (Chef de Clan)** who pulled his way to the front. Jumping nicely, he had fortunately built up a lead of a few lengths by the time he was baulked by a loose horse at Becher's Brook and was carried along the fence, unseating Tony McCoy and leaving **Hedgehunter (Montelimar)** in the lead sooner than planned. The Irish challenger, a beaten third when falling at the final fence last year, had been racing less exuberantly this time and was ridden with supreme confidence. Two fences from home, ten runners still looked to be in with a chance but the favourite jumped the last two in good style and was given his head on the final run-in, sprinting clear for an easy victory. **Royal Auclair (Garde Royale)** and **It Takes Time (Montelimar)** had both made ground on the second circuit to take the placings, with the Carrie Ford-ridden **Forest Gunner (Gunner B)** an honourable fifth after appearing not to see out the marathon trip.

Ashley Brook (Magical Wonder) gained ample compensation for his unlucky defeat in Cheltenham's Arkle Chase when he stumbled badly at the last and was beaten a length. He took up his customary front-running role yeaterday, setting a fast pace and proving much too strong for his rivals, drawing clear over the final three fences.

Jockey Paddy Brennan stated after the race that this was the best horse he had ridden or would ever ride, and that this race was a bonus, the horse being a three-miler and ideal Cheltenham Gold Cup material.

The seven-year-old is the only winner to date produced by **Seamill (Lafontaine)**, who scored three times on the flat up to 11 furlongs. She is a half-sister to two winners, including a hurdles scorer, out of the juvenile winner **Pearl Reef (Main Reef)**. The third dam, the winning **Gulf Pearl** mare **Pearl Grey**, bred three winners and is herself a half-sister to the Belmont Stakes victor **Celtic Ash**, Prix Kergorlay winner **Ashavan**, US Stakes winner **North Pole** and French Listed victrix **Red Wood**.
